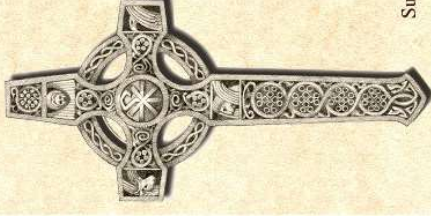
Prayer and Evening Service will continue next week.
