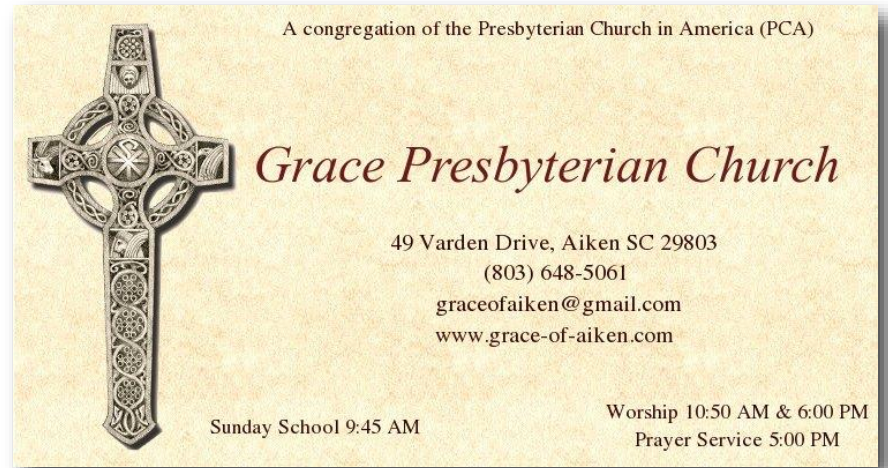
## Announcements
