Officer elections and annual budget and business meeting will be conducted following morning service. All members should participate in the election process.

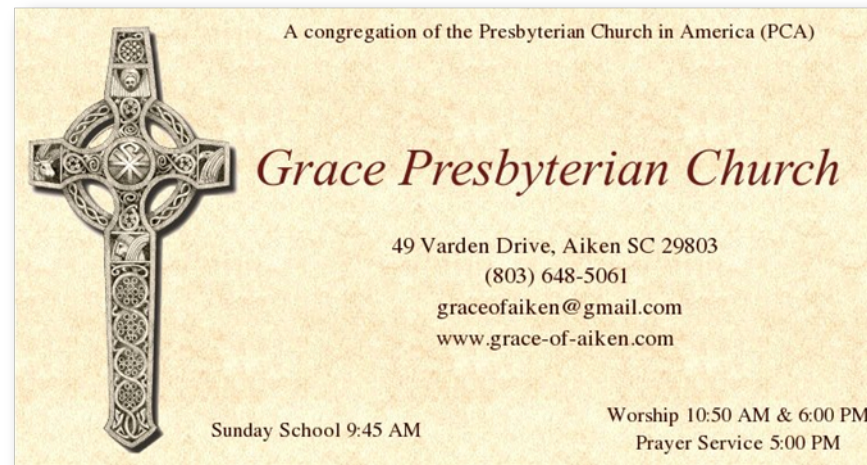
Tonight at 5pm, all church committees – education, fellowship, missions, WIC, teachers, bible studies – will start off the new year with prayer before the evening service.
