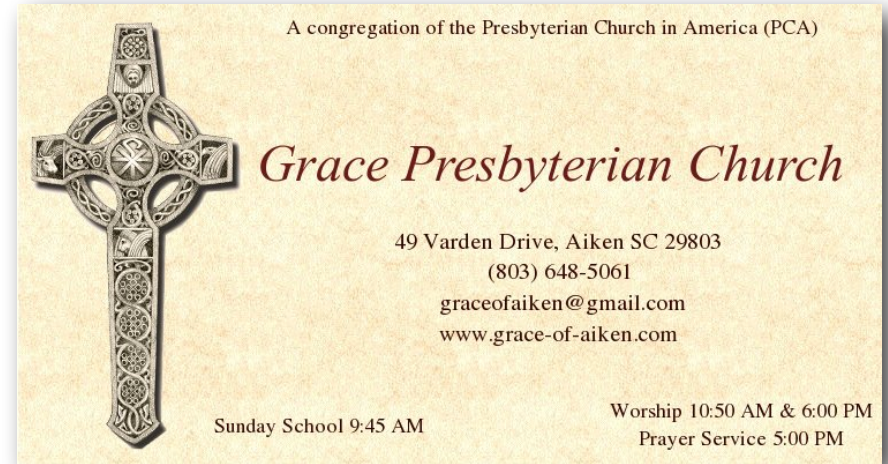
There is a **Beach Day & Shark Fishing Trip** planned for **Saturday, June 4** at Isle of Palms. For details, see Pastor Greg.
